Purpose: To meet the needs of Idaho's Military Guard and Reserve personnel (individuals and families) from all branches.

Who Can Attend: Idaho's National Guard and Reserve service & family members (all branches) including singles and spouses who are "on their own" with or without children are eligible. Non-military families (e.g. friends and relatives) may apply after June 1. Register promptly to share a fun experience, enjoy the beautiful outdoors, reduce stress, relax, meet new friends, enjoy your family and sing by the campfire.

How Do I Register My Family:

Applications (with payment) will be accepted on a first come first served basis. A registration packet will be mailed (schedule and maps included) and must be returned with completed health forms to reserve space. A confirmation will be emailed when registration is complete. Registration cancellations are subject to a \$40.00 per person fee after June 5.

How Does "Family Camp" Work:

Rustic cabins house families or bring your own tent or camper (no hookups available). Shower facilities. Adults and children participate in separate and combined activities. 4-H Super Sitters (trained babysitters) and Teen Camp Counselors and Adult Volunteers monitor and lead children's activities. Team building and educational, fun activities create lasting family memories.
